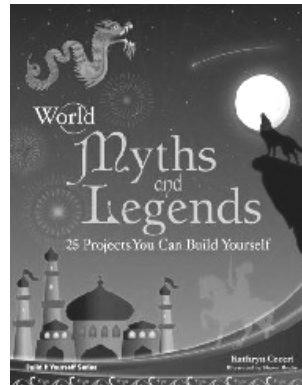
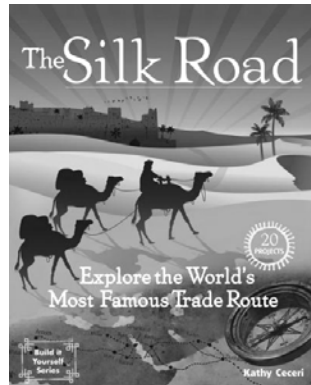
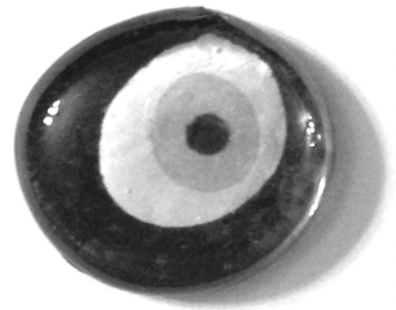
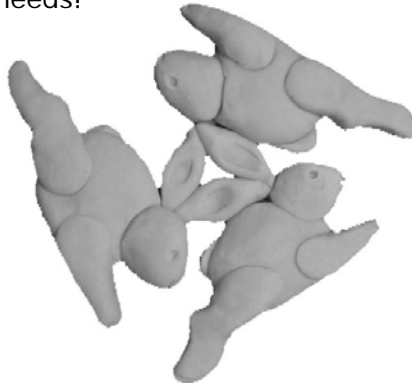


2011 Summer Library Program

What? Hands-on programs exploring stories, art and inventions from around the world

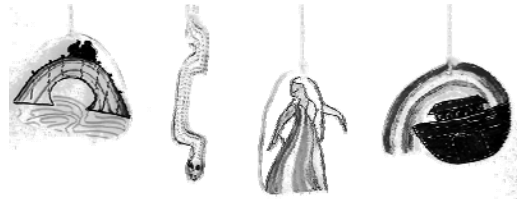
How long? 1-2 hours
